ORDER ON PETITION FOR APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY GUARDIAN AND TEMPORARY CONSERVATOR

Upon petition for appointment of temporary guardian and temporary conservator and upon hearing, this Court determines that there presently is no guardian and no conservator of _____ and that an emergency exists requiring the appointment of a temporary guardian and temporary conservator for said person.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That _____ be and hereby is appointed temporary guardian of _____.

2. That the temporary guardian shall have the following limited powers and duties necessary to address the emergency:

To have custody of said incapacitated person, to establish said person's place of abode, and to place said person in any hospital or other institution for care in the same manner as otherwise provided by law.

To make provisions for the care, comfort and maintenance of said incapacitated person and to take reasonable care of said person's clothing, furniture, vehicles and other personal effects.

To give or withhold consents or approvals related to medical or other professional care, counsel, treatment or service of said incapacitated person.

3. That _____ be and hereby is appointed temporary conservator of _____.

4. That the temporary conservator shall have the following limited powers and duties necessary to address the emergency:

- To collect, hold retain and maintain the assets of the incapacitated person.
- To receive additions to the incapacitated person's estate.
- To pay the incapacitated person's ordinary and necessary bills associated with the incapacitated person's care and maintenance using the incapacitated person's assets.
- Other: _____

5. That the temporary guardian shall file with this Court a report of the temporary guardian's actions as temporary guardian hereof and shall file with this Court copies of all medical reports at the hearing as may be required by the Court. The temporary conservator shall file an Account with this Court at the hearing according to law.

6. This appointment shall not exceed 6 months from the date of entry of this ex parte order.

Pursuant to M.R.Prob.P. 79(a) and at the specific direction of the Court, the Register shall enter on the docket that this Order is incorporated by reference.
