ORDER OF COMPLETE SETTLEMENT  
UNDER 18-C M.R.S. §3-1001 OR §3-1002

Upon the Petition of \_\_\_\_\_ and after hearing or  
opportunity for hearing, the Court finds:

- That the decedent died  testate  intestate and, if applicable, that the Will dated \_\_\_\_\_ and Codicil(s) dated \_\_\_\_\_ constitute the Last Will and Testament of the Decedent;
- That the Personal Representative has filed an accounting with the Court, which has been approved;
- That no accounting has been filed with the Court and none is required;
- That the heirs or devisees hereinafter named should be recipients of the Estate of the Decedent in the amounts and to the extent set forth below;

- That the time for presenting claims which arose prior to death has expired and there are no known claims outstanding;
- That notice of hearing on the pending Petition has been given to all persons in the manner provided by law; and
- Other:

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Estate be settled in the above-named heirs or devisees or both, as specified, and that the Personal Representative herein be and hereby is authorized and directed to deliver and distribute title and possession of the assets of the Estate to the extent and in the amounts (with proportional income, if any) and to the persons named above; that upon making such delivery, said Personal Representative shall be fully and finally released and discharged from the trust herein and, the Personal Representative, together with the sureties, shall be released and discharged from bond and any and all liability arising in connection with the performance of duties as Personal Representative, and the administration of this Estate shall be closed. The Court (if applicable) also ORDERS as follows:

Pursuant to M.R.Prob.P. 79(a) and at the specific direction of the Court, the Register shall enter on the docket that this Order is incorporated by reference.
