1. Notice: A Conservator shall give notice of the filing of a revised plan, along with a copy of the revised plan, to the Respondent, all persons entitled to notice under 18-C M.R.S. § 5-411(5) or a subsequent order and other persons as the Court determines. The notice must include a statement of the right to object to the revised plan and be given not later than 14 days after the filing.²
