To assist the court in its *in camera* review of the file, a Department representative may identify those portions of the records that the Department asserts should not be released because they are either not relevant or contain particularly sensitive confidential information. The Court shall conduct an *in camera* review of those portions so marked and determine whether and under what conditions, if any, to release them.

The parties' attorneys shall be permitted to review those portions of the records that the Court has not excluded based upon its *in camera* review. The records are to remain in the Court Clerk / Register's office at all times. No duplicates or copies are to be made of any of the records and no information contained in the records is to be disclosed to any party except by further order of the Court.

In the event that any attorney desires to receive copies of any of the records reviewed by him/her to discuss the contents of the records with anyone, or to make use of the contents of the records for any purpose, he or she shall list the documents or information sought to be released and present such request to the Court. The Court will then review the records and make further order as to that request.
