FINDINGS

- A. All necessary consents, releases or terminations of parental rights have been duly executed and filed;
- B. An adoption study was required and filed not required;
- C. All required notices have been served;
- D. A report of disbursements and expenses was required and filed not required;
- E. Petitioner(s) is/are (a) suitable adopting parent(s) and desire(s) to establish a parent-child relationship between the petitioner and adoptee;
- F. The best interests of the adoptee are served by adoption; and
- G. All other statutory requirements have been met.
- H. The parties have been informed of the existence of the adoption registry and the services available through the State of Maine Registrar of Vital Statistics under 22 M.R.S. § 2706-A.
